Management Committee

New Hours Many members expressed a desire for extended Sunday hours so those who work during the week can maximize the benefit of a pool membership on the weekend. Therefore, we have adjusted our hours of operation to 10:30am to 8:00pm daily to better serve all of our members. This still allows the early birds plenty of time to enjoy the facility during the week while giving those with less flexible schedules the ability to use the pool more often on the weekend.

Competition Pool—Adult Only Hours

For the 2010 season, the competition pool will have scheduled “Adult Only” hours. The following schedule has been approved by the LSRC board. The shallow end is reserved for adults all of the time. The deep well will be open to all swimmers as indicated. It will be in effect unless the swim team is using the pool, or the management company determines that the space must be available for additional swimmers.

Smoking Section The majority of people who responded to the 2009 Satisfaction Survey expressed interest in a smoke-free facility. However, we understand that other members choose to smoke and have enjoyed that right at LSRC for many years. As a compromise, the board of directors has designated a smoking area.

Tables and chairs will be set up in the grassy area between the pool deck and the pump house. This is the only area inside the facility gates where smoking is permitted. Because a number of members may wish to use this area, we ask that you use it only when smoking to keep the section available to all smokers.

Please note that smoking is allowed in the parking lots and areas outside the fence. However, we ask that all members carefully extinguish all tobacco products and be

courteous by not smoking near entrances where children and members are coming into the facility.

This smoking policy is a pool rule and will be strictly enforced by VSCM. Members and guests who do not comply will be warned and may be asked to leave the facility. Repeated offenses will be reviewed by the Grievance Committee and could result in membership suspension or termination.

Management Company LSRC has been a self-managed facility since our opening day in 1957 and many may wonder “why change now?” after enjoying so many years without relying on a third-party for support. There are many answers to this question but the most important are safety, technical expertise, and time.

Like many facilities, we are faced with limited volunteer support and outsourcing to a professional company is necessary in order to manage the overwhelming task of pool maintenance. Although there are many B&G tasks that will not be managed through Virginia Swim Club Management, outsourcing has eliminated the bulk of the responsibility for this committee.

VSCM has over eight years of pool management experience and strictly abides by standards outlined by The Association of Pool & Spa Professionals (APSP) and the National Pool & Spa Institute. Further, they have the highest standards regarding lifeguard certification and training as outlined by The American Red Cross.

While we are confident that VSCM will be a positive addition to our community, we also understand that such significant changes take some time to get used to. As a partner, we feel strongly that VSCM will work with us to resolve any issue and to ensure that your enjoyment and safety remain top priority. The board will closely monitor progress and performance this season and we look forward to hearing your feedback.

Snack Bar Workers VSCM does not, however, provide Snack Bar workers.

That’s still our job! We are in the process of contacting our employees from last summer to check their availability for the 2010 season. Membership Committee

In this difficult economy, LSRC is feeling the same pinch that you feel. We've had to make difficult decisions to increase dues and offer member incentives to try to increase revenue to cover expenses and plan for much needed renovations. And, with your help, these changes will help restore our club to the flourishing community it deserves to be!

Senior Memberships: We've added new membership categories for members who are at least 65 years old. The new Senior Single and Senior Dual memberships have reduced dues to support our senior members. Look for these new categories on your membership form this year.

Deal of the Decade: For this season only, the board of directors has approved a special price for new members. For only \$499 a family (or just an individual) can become members of LSRC. That includes the initiation fee, the special assessment, and reduced first-year's dues. Tell your friends, tell your neighbors. There will never be a better time to join LSRC!

And if you do tell your friends and neighbors, we've got a reward for you. 71% of our current members heard about LSRC from a friend or neighbor! Many of the decisions we make every day, from restaurants to movies to auto mechanics, are based on the recommendations of our friends. That is why the membership committee is so excited about the joining incentives offered this season! YOU could help secure the future success of LSRC by simply sharing the benefits of club membership with the people you know.

Member Referral Bonus Incentive: All members in good standing are eligible to receive a \$50 bonus for every new member you recruit (regardless of the membership category) once the new member has paid the joining fee in full. For you to receive the bonus, the joining member MUST write your name and telephone number on their application in the space provided. We **will not** accept phone calls or pleas for exceptions after an application has been received. (Give your friends the new member application form included in this newsletter. Be sure to write your name in the "Referred by" block so you get your bonus!)

Steering Committee

The 2008-2009 Board of Directors established a Steering Committee to clarify procedures, policies and guidelines (including grievance procedures) of the association and to make recommendations to the board to put into place such procedures, policies and guidelines where none exist. The committee will also evaluate the condition of the facility and grounds.

We are committed to creating a procedure manual for all LSRC committee chairmen that will serve as a tool for future volunteers. These manuals will not only reference club policies but will provide a timeline of specific duties that must be performed by each chair to ensure the consistent and success-

To be a "member in good standing" you must have paid your dues for the 2010 season. However, if your new recruit joins before you renew, you will still get credit and earn the \$50 bonus. Your referral bonus will be applied as soon as you have paid your renewal fees for the 2010 season and you will begin receiving checks once your dues are received and posted. Bonus checks will be cut once per month.

This is not a lottery. This is not a drawing. This is cash. If you refer a new member and your name is written on the application form and you have paid your dues, you will receive a check for \$50. There is no limit — each new member you bring in will earn you the \$50 bonus.

You won't be doing all this alone. The committee will be putting flyers in the neighborhoods and in the HCPS activities book that goes out to 22,000 students in Henrico County. But, YOU are still our best advertising! Get the word out about LSRC to your friends, neighbors, and co-workers. Encourage everyone you know to attend our Open House days on June 5th or 19th (remember, it's free for them and could be worth \$50 for you!)

Online membership forms & payments: In 2009 we updated our website. This year we've added online registration forms and credit card payment. Go to <http://golsrc.com> and click on the tab for Online Forms. Select the form you need and fill it out. When you click the button to submit your registration, you will be directed to our online shopping cart. Select the membership /swim team options that you want, click Checkout and enter your credit card information. You can even split your membership into two payments! But remember, all renewals are due by April 30. Payments made on May 1 will automatically have the \$30 late fee added.

Membership Passes: VSCM is going to be checking passes carefully. Be sure you have yours. A member of our committee will be at the pool in late May and early June to update membership passes. Pick up your new photo ID passes within one week at the entryway table.

Tennis

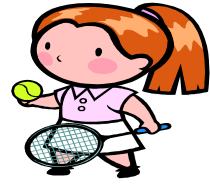

Payments postmarked May 1, 2010 or after will be subject to a \$30 late fee that must be paid before you will be able to use the pool or tennis facilities.

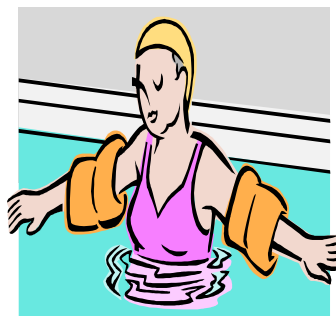

Special Membership Requests

Did you know that LSRC has outlined several Special Membership options to provide our members with flexibility during the summer season? Each option listed below is \$85 per person to whom special membership is extended.

Adult sitter for Member's Children: You can add a babysitter to your membership and the sitter will have club privileges that are limited to the hours that the sitter is employed.

Adult Member as Sitter: If you provide childcare in your home, you may add each child in your care to your membership. Children will have access to the club only when they are in your care.

Member's Grandchildren: If you frequently have your grandchildren during the summer, consider adding them to your membership rather than paying the \$5 guest fee per visit.

Member's Guests: If a member has out of town guests/relatives who will be living in the member's home for an extended period of time, but not permanently, the guest's name may be added to the membership; however, guests will be offered club privileges only when accompanied by the member.

As required by the LSRC by-laws, if you would like to take advantage of one of these options please submit a letter to the Board of Directors explaining your situation. The Board will review each request and the member will be notified with the Board's decision.

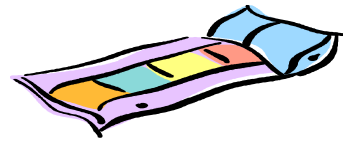

LAKESIDE SWIM & RACQUET CLUB RULES

The following Facility rules are established to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for members and their guests. Members should ensure that their guests read and adhere to these rules. Violation of these rules may result in suspension of privileges. These rules are subject to change by the Board of Directors.

1. The Manager, Assistant Managers, and Lifeguards must be obeyed at all times.
2. Only members and their guests are allowed to use the facilities.
3. Any guest using the facilities must be signed in by a member who is at least age 13 and the member must pay the appropriate guest fee. The member must remain at the facility with their guests.
4. No one under the age of ten years will be allowed admittance to the facility unless accompanied by a person fourteen years old or older.
5. No pets are allowed on the property.
6. Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are not permitted on the property.
7. Illegal substances are not permitted on the property. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. Smoking by underage members or guests is not permitted.
8. Profanity will not be tolerated at LSRC. Offenders will be warned once and then sent off of the property.
9. Chewing gum is not permitted on the property.
10. Bicycles must be parked in the bicycle racks.
11. Skateboards cannot be ridden on the property and must be parked in the bicycle racks.
12. Heely® shoes (shoes with wheels) are not allowed to be worn on the property.
13. The creek is off limits.
14. Swim wear must be worn while in the pool.
15. Only Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted for use in the pools.
16. No snorkels and/or face masks are permitted in the pools.
17. No hard balls (soccer, basketball, baseball, etc.) may be used inside the enclosed pool area except for activities organized by the facility manager or swim coach.
18. Floats and noodles are only allowed during designated float nights except that noodles may be used by adults in the designated "adults only" pool.
19. Eating, drinking, and smoking at the pool edge and in the breezeway are not permitted.
20. Only one person may use the diving board at a time. Wait for the diving board to clear before getting onto the ladder.
21. Swim team diving blocks are off limits, except when used by the swim team during practices/meets.
22. Stay off lane lines and ropes.
23. No talking to the lifeguards on pool duty.
24. Children over the age of five are not permitted in the baby pool.
25. The two lap lanes in the family pool are to be used for lap swimming only. Swimmers will be limited to two per lane. Kickboards may only be used in the lap lanes and must be used properly.
26. Children who are not potty trained must wear swimmy diapers covered with a bathing suit. This applies to all pools.
27. Members' guests are subject to a swimming test prior to entering the water.
28. LSRC reserves the right to restrict water toys brought to the facility.
29. Safety rules must be observed:
 - **NO RUNNING**
 - **NO ROUGHNESS**
 - **ONE BOUNCE ONLY ON DIVING BOARDS**
 - **NO FLIPS OFF OF SIDE OF POOL**
 - **NO FLOATATION DEVICES MAY BE WORN OR CARRIED WHEN JUMPING/DIVING OFF OF DIVING BOARDS (INCLUDING LIFE VESTS)**

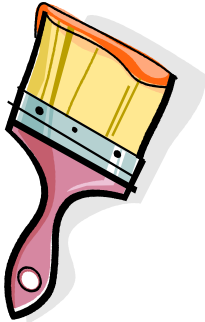

Annual Campaign Fund Contributions

On your dues renewal form, you will find a space for contributions for the Fifth Annual Capital Campaign and the Buildings and Grounds Campaign Funds.

Contributions to the Capital Fund are being set aside to fund improvements to the tennis courts. The repairs to the courts will cost tens of thousands of dollars. If we continue to save and allocate money from the budget, we will at some point be able to make improvements to the tennis courts. Thanks to those who have contributed to this fund in the past.

We are creating a **Buildings & Grounds Campaign Fund** this season so we can begin to set aside money that can be used on making improvements on the LSRC facility. In addition to being an aging facility (operating with many original parts and equipment) there are also a number of things members would like to see, such as fresh paint, new chairs and loungers, and landscaping.
