A Note from the LSRC Board President and Vice President

We are excited for the upcoming 2020 season! Last summer was an amazing one, with many new members and families to enjoy the pool and activities. Attendance increased last summer, which is wonderful, and will allow us to keep doing family and movie nights.

Based on member feedback, the pool will open again for two weekends after Labor Day this season. The Board is also in discussions with the pool management company to open at 10:30am during the weekdays after Memorial Day until public schools are out on June 12th, but keep in mind this is a work-in-progress. It is not yet resolved with SwimMetro. It really seems like our pool is waking back up with a great sense of pride and community!

This year we will be replacing and adding more chairs and recliners, and working on repaving the driveway to the pool. We have some upcoming improvements happening

with the snack bar and membership check in as well. These activities will be done with LSRC funds in the 2020 season.

Our membership committee did a great job with 47 new memberships last summer. **Do you know someone who wants to be a member at LSRC?** Tell your friends and neighbors to come visit during an Open House event. Members can receive incentives for referrals so **check out the Open House dates in the membership section of the newsletter!** New memberships and renewals fund our improvements and everyday activities. We are happy to announce that our membership rates will not increase for the 2020 season.

Check-In

We will continue using the breezeway entrance for the check-in area. **All members and members' guest(s) are required to check-in before entering the facility.** During check-in you will be required to show your pool pass, sign in guest(s), and pay the guest fee prior to you or your guest entering the facility. If you forget your pool pass or do not have one, a photo I.D. may be required for all members over 17 years old to enter the Club. To validate your original pool pass for 2020, we will place a 2020 sticker on your pass when you check in on your 1st visit. If for some reason you did not get a pool pass last year or lost your original pool pass, we can create a new one for you.

Guest Fees

As noted last year, we have a guest fee because it brings in much needed revenue to the Club. We are aware that some guests have used the pool without paying the fee. **As a reminder this is against the LSRC guest policy and By-Laws.** We trust that all members of LSRC will approach the summer with a sense of responsibility and ownership concerning guest-fee rules and expectations. Guest fees this year remain the same, \$7 per person. You can purchase a booklet of 10 guest passes for \$50. That's a savings of \$20! And remember, any membership that donates 8 hours of volunteer time as we get the facility ready for the season will be given one free booklet of guest passes to use during the 2020 season. **Please note: Guest passes are sold only to members.** A guest is not permitted to purchase an individual guest pass or book of passes. Guests must be accompanied by an LSRC member. Guest passes are a final sale product, and there are no refunds for unused guest passes during a season. Any guest passes bought in one season expire at the end of that season and cannot be used again during any future season.

Snack Bar

Snack Bar Managing Director: Cathy Preble

Recruiting has begun for part-time snack bar associates to work the snack bar and membership check-in. This year, we are also recruiting for a part-time Snack Bar Manager who will be responsible for overseeing and managing the daily operations of the Snack Bar. More details can be found at www.golsrc.com under "About LSRC - Employment". Applications are due by 4/03/2020. Work permits are required for employees aged 14 or 15. The snack bar will follow the same Club opening times during the season and close at 7:30 pm Monday - Thursday and 8:00 pm Friday - Sunday. Hours are subject to change due to inclement weather, days that have low member turnout, or other unforeseen circumstances. The snack bar will also be open during some of the special after hour events offered by the Recreation Committee. The grill will be serving grilled food through the snack bar on selected weekend days two to four times a month.

Day Care Program

For the past three seasons we have invited up to five child care centers to use our pool during specified hours, generally on weekday mornings when the pool was at low capacity. This has been a profitable endeavor and helpful in raising a portion of the much needed revenue for our Club. We plan to continue with the same child care centers during the 2020 season. Lifeguards have reported that these groups have followed the rules and were respectful. Some members had questions about the hours these groups would be using the pools. Management plans to post the schedule in the breezeway on the bulletin board. The schedule will be subject to change due to rain make up days or other unforeseen circumstances.

Management Company

We are entering our second year of our three year renewed contract with SwimMetro Management, Inc. The Management Committee will meet with SwimMetro lifeguards in early May to discuss our Club's expectations and troubleshoot potential problems for the coming season.

LSRC Lifeguard Positions:

Did you know that you can apply for a lifeguard position with SwimMetro from our website? If your teen is interested in working at LSRC as a lifeguard this summer, the link to SwimMetro can be found at www.golsrc.com under "About LSRC – Employment". Applicants must be at least 15 years old to apply and have taken (or plan to take) a lifeguard certification class. When applying, please choose to work at LSRC-Lakeside Pool. We really enjoy having some of our young adults working at our pool!

Adult Swim Hours

The competition pool will again have scheduled "Adult Only" hours. This schedule will be in effect unless the pool is being used for swim lessons, swim team practice, or the management company determines that the day's demand requires opening the competition pool to all swimmers. Both pools will also be open to all swimmers on holidays.

Please be mindful that discarding cigarette butts anywhere else on the property (i.e. throwing them on the ground) is littering.

LSRC's smoking policy is a Club standard and rule that will be strictly enforced by SwimMetro. Members and guests who do not comply will be warned and may be asked to leave the facility.

Membership Committee

Committee Chair: Mike Hall

The Board is pleased to report a successful 2019 season attracting new memberships to the Club. With 47 new memberships (primarily in the Family & Household levels), the Club exceeded its budgeted goal by 10 additional memberships. The added revenue from those extra memberships certainly helped improve the financial status of LSRC.

Referring a "New" Member: The Club is offering existing members the chance to earn a book of 10 guest passes by being the referring agent for a "new" paid membership that joins LSRC. If you refer a second new membership, you can earn an additional 5 guest passes. Maximize the chance to receive free guest passes and encourage family/friends to join LSRC this season.

2019's Renewals Status: The report on the membership renewals also paints a positive status in maintaining slight membership growth. The Club sustained a renewal percentage of 82% with renewal of 184 memberships, exceeding the budgeted goal by 7 memberships. This is a renewal trend that has been in place for several years, and it is extremely financially important to the Club to sustain this level of memberships. Fluctuating membership renewal rates makes it somewhat difficult for the Club to estimate the

projected budget amount of revenue for renewals, but this is a task that the Finance Committee has improved upon with use of renewals' data from the past several.

Renew Your Membership: We also have good news for our active members who can renew their 2020 membership with LSRC: No Dues Increase This Year!!! The Board of Directors, in association with the Membership Committee, decided to retain the dues/fees rates that have been in place for the previous three years, so the renewal rates remain the same. Here is the 2020 dues/fees chart for renewal membership levels:

Reminder, the Late Fee: Please make sure to pay your renewal dues no later than April 30th, otherwise a standard \$50 late fee will apply to all renewals made on May 1st or later. Pay on time, avoid the late fee.

Installment Payments for Renewals: Active members are eligible to pay their 2020 dues/fees via installment payments. If you wish to pay in installments, here are the 2 options:

1. **Pay by Check:** Mail application with 1st payment. Treasurer will then create an invoice in the membership website database www.golsrc.com where the payments will be subtracted from the total membership renewal amount. Please mail in check payments with member name clearly noted on check. Members will not be allowed to enter the pool until membership dues are paid in full. Treasurer will email confirmation of each payment once payment has been received and entered into the database.

2. **Pay via Credit Card.** Mail application renewal. Email katiemck3@gmail.com your desired payment amount and number of payments. Treasurer will then create an invoice within the membership website database www.golsrc.com for each payment amount (including the 3% credit card fee). You, as a member, can login and make your payment via credit card. Members will not be allowed to enter the pool until membership dues are paid in full.

“Open House” Events: This summer, LSRC will host two “Open House” events, on Sunday, May 24th of opening weekend, and Sunday, June 7th. There are no rain dates for

these events. The Membership Committee volunteers will provide new and renewal membership services on those two days. Remind your family and friends to come to the pool and enjoy a free day of swimming fun, all the while encouraging them to join LSRC (that's the purpose of the events: to obtain more new members).

Opening Weekend, Membership Committee Services: As in past years, the Membership Committee will be available to new members and those renewing to assist with questions, application forms, and payments. Look for the volunteers from the committee just beyond the main Breezeway entrance under the canopy to the right.
