POLICY DEFINING MEMBER GUESTS and GUEST PASSES

The following statements reflect the Lakeside Swim & Racquet Club's **policy** governing member guests and the fees assessed to guests of members. Within this document, Lakeside Swim & Racquet Club shall be referred to as "the Club."

NOTE: These rules do not apply to the guidelines covering guests of members or non-members who have paid fees to rent the picnic pavilion, the small canopy or the full facility. The rental agreement for those events defines fees for guests.

1. An active member (one who has paid all dues & fees for the current fiscal year) of the Club is permitted to bring a guest or guests to the facility. There is no maximum limit to the number of guests a member can bring to the Club during a single visit.
 - a. An "Honorary" or "Lifetime" member is considered to be an active member for purposes of this policy.
 2. Any guest entering the facility must be accompanied by the host member during the period when the guest is present at the facility.
 3. A guest is not permitted to enter the facility without the host member being with the guest. This requirement is to protect the Club for safety, legal, and insurance purposes.
 4. Guests are required to vacate the premises when the host member also leaves the facility.
 5. Any member who brings a guest must pay the respective fee for that guest to be present at the Club.
 - a. The Club sells an individual (aka single) guest pass to a member at a reasonable cost.
 - b. As a courtesy to members, the Club also sells a book of 10 guest passes. The book of passes costs less per unit of pass than if bought as a single guest pass.
 - c. The individual guest pass and the book of guest passes are sold to members via the Snack Bar.
 - d. The fee for the individual pass or the book of passes is set each season by the Board of Directors.
 6. A guest is not permitted to purchase an individual guest pass nor a book of passes. Guest passes are sold only to members.
 7. Age requirements for bringing guests:
 - a. A child associate member must be at least 13 years old to bring a child guest 17 years or younger into the facility.
 - b. A child associate member must be at least 10 years old to bring an adult guest, who is at least 18 years old, into the facility.
 8. Exceptions to the rule for which guest must pay the guest fee:
 - a. Infants, babies, toddlers or small children who must be cared for at all times by a parent or guardian and who cannot be left alone or unattended do not have to pay a guest fee.
 - b. Any child under the age of 18 who is not ambulatory and cannot swim does not have to pay a guest fee, and any guest who is in a wheelchair is not required to pay a fee.
 - c. Any other guest not defined within these exceptions pays the guest fee, regardless of whether swimming in the pools or not.

9. Any guest within the facility must obey the rules of the Club at all times; otherwise, the guest will be requested to leave the Club.
10. Any guest who fails to observe the safety or other rules of the Club can be permanently banned from the premises, as determined by the Board of Directors.
11. Any member who brings a guest within the facility is expected to follow the guest registration procedures as set forth by the Board of Directors and/or the Management-Operations Committee for that season.
12. A member who brings a guest within the facility and who does not register the guest and pay the appropriate guest fee will be issued a warning for the first violation of this offense.
13. If a member continues to abuse the guest registration expectations, the Board of Directors reserves the right to take other appropriate corrective action as it determines relevant.
14. Guest passes are a final sale product and there are no refunds for unused guest passes during a season.
15. Any guest passes bought in one season expire at the end of that season and fiscal year and cannot be used again during any future season.
